PRO – PROFESSIONAL LEAVE

ELIGIBILITY:

- 1. An employee must be post-probationary in their current bargaining unit, unless the Professional Leave of Absence is for student teaching.
 - a. A probationary administrator is eligible for a Professional Leave of Absence if the administrator passed probation as a CCSD licensed employee.
 - b. A probationary school police administrator is eligible for a Professional Leave of Absence if the school police administrator passed probation as a CCSD school police officer.
- 2. An employee must have completed two full years of employment in the employee's current bargaining unit, unless the Professional Leave of Absence is for student teaching.
- 3. A Professional Leave of Absence may be granted for college or university study or other professional improvement relating to K-12 education and/or school district operations, including but not limited to student teaching and educational internships.

SUPPORTING DOCUMENTATION:

1. Must submit proof of college or university enrollment
