


# Clark County School District High School Suspension and Expulsion Data

- The graphics are drawn from the Office of Civil Rights website and are based on data supplied by CCSD (www.ocrdata.ed.gov).
- The figures reported are compositional and based on African American expulsion rates, not ratios of risk or relative risk.
- Without more details, it is hard to verify the accuracy of the numbers reported.
- For our project, the data are valid for its intended purpose.
- The displays we produced are similar to, but not identical to, what would emerge if we used risk ratios and/or relative risk ratios.
- Nonetheless, the displays we produced are "directionally correct" and serve to spark helpful discussion about a problem.
- The reported data represents both mandatory and discretionary expulsions.
- Once Dr. Reschly's school-by-school analysis is complete, we will rely on his school-by-school findings (using risk and relative risk ratios).




































