## **CLARK COUNTY SCHOOL DISTRICT**

The Board shall instruct the Superintendent through written policies that prescribe the organizational progress to be achieved on the Board Vision, Core Values, the District's Strategic Plan and other support strategies, allowing the Superintendent to use any reasonable interpretation of these policies.

## Accordingly:

- 1. The Board shall develop policies instructing the Superintendent to achieve certain results for certain recipients at specified costs. These policies shall be developed systematically from the broadest, most general level to more specifically defined levels, and shall be called Board Vision, Core Values, the District's Strategic Plan and other support strategies policies. The policies include Balanced Governance™ Tracking and Reporting Protocols as described in GP-4.2: Board Members' Principles of Operation.
- 2. As long as the Superintendent uses any reasonable interpretation of the Board Vision, Core Values, the District's Strategic Plan and other support strategies policies, the Superintendent is authorized to establish all further procedures, policies and regulations, make all decisions, take all actions, establish all practices, and develop all activities.
- 3. The Board may change its Vision, Core Values, the District's Strategic Plan and other support strategies policies at any time it chooses. However, the Board shall support the Superintendent and staff in the enforcement of approved policy until what time the policy is officially revised and approved by the Board.
- 4. The Superintendent or the Board may author policies to direct the operation of the District and the Board shall retain final approval.
